

INTRODUCTION

American and British literature contains thousands of proverbs. They represent a potpourri of time-tested, common-sense aphorisms, many of which have their origins in other countries and date even before the actual establishment of America as a sovereign nation. I remember reading about an elementary school teacher who, wanting to convey creatively some of these national and international proverbs to her students, decided to provide the first part of the proverb and then have her young learners fill in the remainder. One little girl received, "A bird in the hand...."The teacher expected to hear, "...is worth two in the bush.", but this youngster blurted out "...is sure to go to the bathroom!" While I am certain that there is truth in both versions, I want to write about the Jewish Proverbs of Scripture with a far more serious intent than comes from this humorous incident or even from helpful proverbs of mere human origin.

I first visited Russia (then the USSR) in February 1991, and have returned several times since (now a part of the Commonwealth of Independent States [CIS]). It struck me then that here stands a prominent nation which desperately needs a completely new set of absolute ethical and moral principles, i.e. Proverbs, to guide both the government and the people as they transition through violently dramatic spiritual, economic, political, ethical, and social upheavals, caused partly by their many decades of government-imposed, national atheism.

The same need exists in my own country – the United States of America. If I had one message to give the CEOs, educators, political leaders, media pundits, and social scientists of our day, it would be the teaching of Proverbs, which majors on making one wise unto **This** is a unique book on a unique part of Scripture. Mayhue introduces us to Solomon, the writer of Proverbs, and then gets to grips with the book itself and its message. He answers some of the most frequently asked questions about Proverbs and how the book has immediate and pressing relevance to Christians today.

Then, he re-organises the text of the entire book of Proverbs into six life applications - spiritual, personal, family, intellectual, market-place and societal each also having particular themes highlighted within them.

PRACTICING PROVERBS is one book with multiple uses; devotional, small group discipleship book, resource for the biblical counselor and for teaching Christian ethics and morality.

Most importantly of all, this is a book to help the reader develop a life that glorifies the source of all wisdom - God.
